STRESS AWARENESS MONTH - APRIL

April is stress awareness month.

We all have times when we feel low, anxious or overwhelmed. But little things, like talking to a friend or taking a moment to breathe, can really help us feel much better.

BLADDER CANCER AWARENESS MONTH – MAY

May is bladder cancer awareness month.

Did you know that, in the UK, <u>over 10,000</u> people are diagnosed with bladder cancer each year?

Symptoms:

- Blood in your urine
- A need to urinate on a more frequent basis
- Sudden urges to urinate
- A burning sensation when passing urine

If bladder cancer reaches an advanced stage and has spread, symptoms can include:

- Pelvic pain
- Bone pain
- Unintentional weight loss
- Swelling of the legs

You should contact a GP if you have any of these symptoms and they persist.

Cervical Screening Awareness Week-June 2025

Cervical screening checks the health of your cervix and helps find any abnormal changes before they can turn into cancer. It is important to regularly attend your cervical screening as finding high risk HPV early means you can be monitored for abnormal cell changes.

Abnormal changes can be treated so they do not get a chance to turn into cervical cancer.

If you are aged 25-65 or 65+ with a recent abnormal test result, contact the surgery to book an appointment with our practice Nurse.
